▶ **What is a Pow Wow?**

Pow Wows, by definition, are Native American gatherings in which American Indians sing, dance, reconnect with old friends and celebrate their rich ancestral histories. There are several different stories of how the gathering started.

▶ **I am a dancer/singer/drummer/etc. and I want to participate or compete in the event. How do I do that?**

Dancers may come and dance at any time according to their appropriate dance style. Drums/singers are invite only and must be with an invited drum.

▶ **I am a food/craft/etc. vendor and I want to sell my wares at the Pechanga Pow Wow. How do I do that?**

All vendor spots are fully committed and sold out. Please email Vendor Coordinator Chris Medellin-Lopez and powwow@pechanga.com for more information.

▶ **What ages are allowed to watch a Pow Wow?**

The Pechanga Pow Wow is free and open to all ages. Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. The Pow Wow is a fantastic display of Native American culture, heritage and presents a learning opportunity for all ages to know more about Native life and culture.

▶ **Will alcohol be sold at the Pow Wow?**

No, alcohol will not be sold at the pow wow as it's a family-friendly event and will not be permitted at the event. Please visit Pechanga.com/eat for hours and days of operation of all of Pechanga Resort Casino's bars and restaurants.

▶ **Will there be food at the Pow Wow?**

Yes, food will be available for purchase from multiple vendors. Many will feature Native American foods such as fry bread, buffalo burgers, succotash and more.

▶ **Will there be tickets?**

No. There are no tickets to the Pechanga Pow Wow, though capacities will be enforced so it's best to come early for good viewing.

▶ **Where can I park?**

Yes. The best viewing place will be at the back event lawn located in front of The Cove. Fireworks will be on Saturday, January 4, 2025 at 7 p.m. and will last approximately 10-12 minutes. No personal fireworks of any kind are allowed.
